Many Hands Make Light Work – as my Dad used to say (father of 8). Cathy Evans is an awesome Quilt Show Chairman and we are lucky that she has agreed to chair the show for another year. But as she said, it takes all of us to make the show a success and isn't it fun celebrating our accomplishments? Congratulations to all of our Viewer's Choice winners also. The quilts truly speak for themselves and to the artistry of the makers.

Thom Atkins of Santa Cruz will be our speaker at the April meeting with "Beaded Quilts, Start to Finish". He will also have a workshop the following day - "Beads I, Bead Embroidery for Quilters". There is a \$25 kit fee in addition to the class fee. The class will look at beads, their shapes, varieties of finishes, and their use on quilts to create texture and color changes in the surface. You

will learn the basic stitches for applying beads, and what they do to the surface of the quilt, and how the application of beads quilts the surface. There are a few more spots left in the class. Since there is virtually no prep work before class, you may choose to sign up after you see Thom's beautiful work. The class will be held the day after the general meeting from 9:00-3:00 at the Fremont Conference Center.

Sandy Klop of American Jane Patterns will be here at the May meeting with a great trunk show and great items from her company. Sandy will also be teaching

"Wagon Wheels" the following day. Wasn't Sandy's choice of fabrics outstanding for this paper-pieced sample? There is a pattern fee of approximately \$6 that will be payable to the guild, in addition to the \$25 class fee. The class will be again held the day following the



general meeting at the Fremont Conference Center from 9:00-3:00.

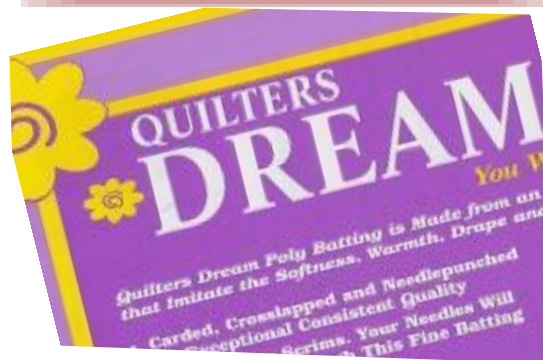
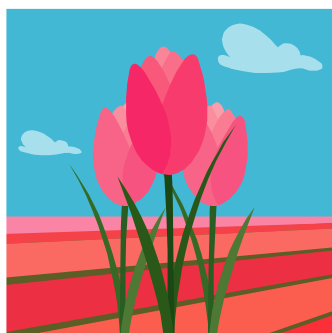
