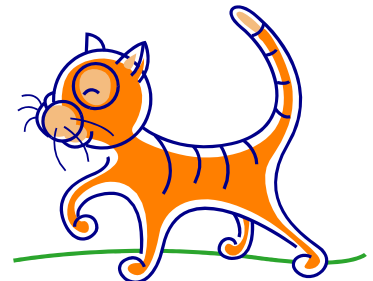

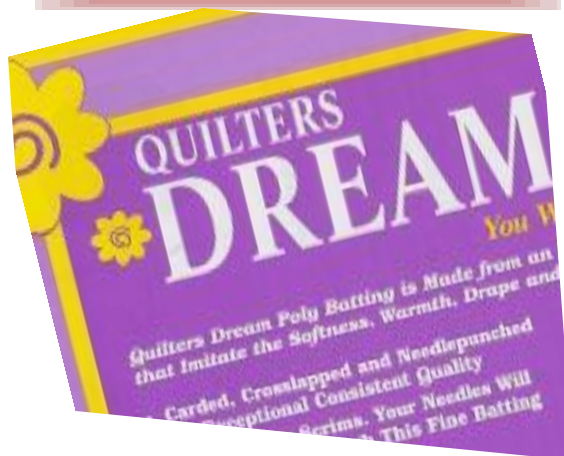

Grievances: If a member has a grievance concerning the Guild, they must bring the grievance to the Board and it must be approved before it can be presented to the General Meeting of members and guests.

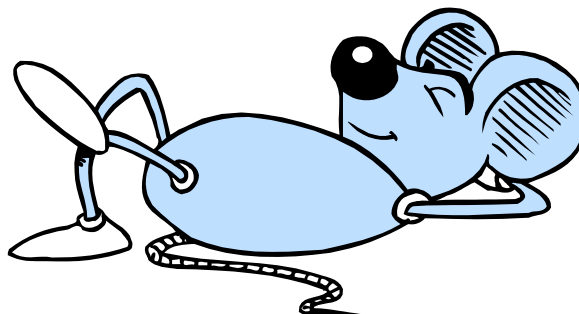

Meetings:

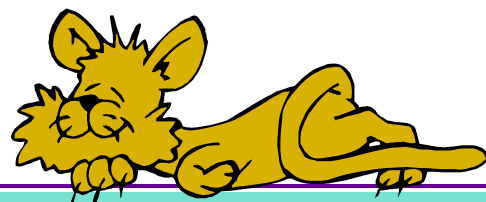
