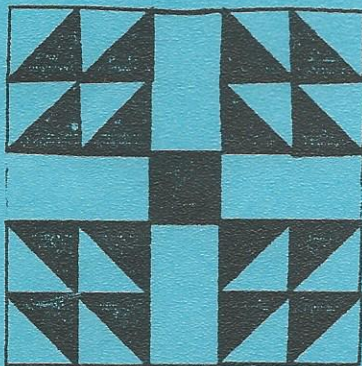


Valley Quilt Guild Block of the Month-April

This block, a variation of Handy Andy called Wedding Ring, is to be made for the May meeting so you can have it for June, the month of weddings.

Make it dressy by using a white-on-white and your favorite shade of bright rose or pink or burgundy for the contrasting triangles.



Cut center 2 1/2" square from your choice of bright fabric.
Cut 4 four 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" rectangles from white-on-white.
Make 16 half square triangles from white-on-white and your choice of contrasting fabric using your favorite method. Square up or trim to 2 1/2" squares before proceeding.

Assembly

Use 1/4 inch seams throughout.

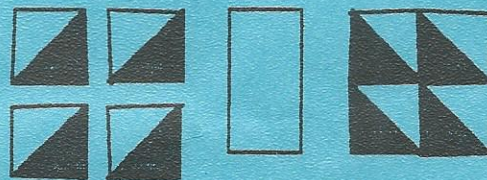
Assemble 4 (four) half square triangles as shown. Assemble 3 more corner units from half square triangles as shown.

Be sure to turn triangles facing the proper way as shown in diagrams.

Assemble top and bottom rows using corner units and white on white rectangle.

Assemble middle row using white on white rectangles and contrasting square.

Assemble rows as shown. Square up block to 10 1/2 inches.
